START & FINISH: The Royal Oak Inn, Clee Hill, on the Ludlow to Cleobury Mortimer Road, Shropshire
Starting order: Saturday: Newcomers, Clubman Sidecars, Intermediates then British Championship Sidecars. Sunday: Solos followed by Sidecars as on Saturday. The order of starting for all sidecar drivers will be determined by a computer based random selection made by the organisers at the close of entries. First crew away both days 11.00 am.

ENTRIES: to the Secretary of the meeting with the entry fee of £30.00 for two days (or £20.00 each day) for sidecars and £17.00 for solos plus *your e-mail address* (preferred) or two stamped addressed envelopes by Saturday 24th March 2012 Limited to 40 Sidecars both days and 25 Midland Centre Solos on Sunday. The club has applied for a blanket cover to provide competitors who need it, third party cover to meet RTA requirements on the road section of the Trial. This cover can be purchased when signing on at the start at a cost of £10.00.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration card or SACU Licence. Other riders must produce a licence and Start Permission confirming insurance from their FMN

THE COURSE will be on the road about 25 miles marked with coloured cards (Red –Right, Blue – Left and White – Straight on)
